## BLESS OUR SCHOOLS (September Prayer Focus)

Scripture prayers to pray for students, teachers, school administrators, and school support staff.

1. Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. (Colossians 4:2)
2. Lord, whatever \_\_\_\_\_ does, may he/she work heartily as for the Lord rather than for men. (Colossians 3:23)
3. May \_\_\_\_\_ not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time, he/she will reap a harvest if he/she does not give up. (Galatians 6:9)
4. Lord, help \_\_\_\_\_ prove to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world. (Philippians 2:15)
5. Father, may no one take \_\_\_\_\_ captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ. (Colossians 2:8)
6. Lord, I pray that \_\_\_\_\_ will trust in You and do good. (Psalm 37:3a)
7. May \_\_\_\_\_ lay aside every encumbrance and the sin, which so easily entangles, and let \_\_\_\_\_ run with endurance the race that is set before him/her. (Hebrews 12:1b)
8. Lord, may integrity and honesty protect \_\_\_\_\_ as he/she puts his/her hope in You. (Psalm 25:21)
9. Lord, may \_\_\_\_\_ take joy in doing Your will. May Your instructions be written on his/her heart. (Psalm 40:8)
10. May \_\_\_\_\_ not follow the advice of the wicked, stand around with sinners or join in with mockers. (Psalm 1:1)
11. Lord, I pray that \_\_\_\_\_ will love Your instructions, have great peace and not stumble. (Psalm 119:165)
12. May \_\_\_\_\_ not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of his/her mind, so that \_\_\_\_\_ may prove what the will of God is that which is good and acceptable and perfect. (Romans 12:2)
13. Help \_\_\_\_\_ warn those who are idle and disruptive, encourage the disheartened, help the weak, be patient with everyone. (1 Thessalonians 5:14)
