Since the time of Adam and Eve, everyone has chosen to disobey God. This is called **SIN**. Sin separates us from God and deserves punishment and death.

God had a plan to send the **MESSIAH** to be the perfect solution to our sin problem. The prophet Jeremiah shared about the Messiah in his writings.

Jesus, the Messiah, lived a perfect life, died on the cross for our sins, and rose again.

This **CROSS** is part of a huge mosaic high up on the **WALL** of the Basilica di Sant'Apollinare. It was created in the 6th century in Ravenna, Italy.

He will be God dwelling among His people.

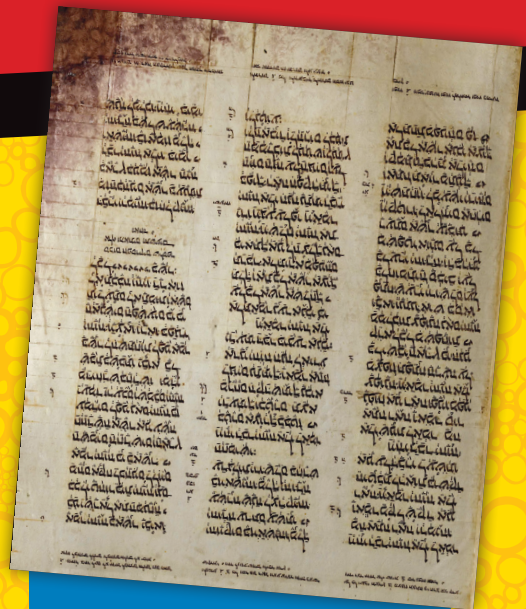

ANCIENT PROMISES

The Aleppo Codex was a full manuscript of the entire Bible copied in about AD 930. This picture shows part of the Book of Jeremiah.

Jeremiah prophesied that God would send the Messiah, make a new covenant with His people, and that Jesus would reign as King forever.

We know God sent Jesus. We know God will keep His promise of making Jesus the King forever because God always keeps His promises!
